



Qualification Criteria

- Only **South African citizens** are eligible for the National Student Financial Aid Scheme (**NSFAS**) bursary scheme.
- A student must be registered or intending to register to study at a **TVET college**.
- Applicants will qualify for funding if they fall within the maximum threshold of up to **R350,000** of combined gross **family income** per annum.
- Persons with a disability with a combined **household income** not more than **R600 000** per annum.
- Returning students (studied prior 2018) will qualify if they fall within the maximum threshold of up to **R122,000** of combined gross family income per annum.

Application dates are communicated on campus at the TVET college.



NSFAS students and prospective NSFAS students are required to open and regularly check their **myNSFAS accounts** for NSFAS funding related information.
